What are Physical Breach Attempts?

Physical Breach Attempts (PBAs) are a way to test your team and that your awareness training when it comes to access management, especially when it comes to physical attempts to gain access to both locations and sensitive data, by having a third-party that has permission to come to one of your locations and attempt to get past your team to gain any information that could be leveraged to hurt either your institution or you customers.

What does infotex offer?
