Shop at websites you trust

To play it safe, consider doing online business only with retailers you trust and have shopped with before.

Avoid Phishing or Other Scams

Clicking on links from untrusted sources in email, text, or the web has risks, including fraud, malware distribution, and credential harvesting.

Beware Attachments!

Avoid opening attachments sent to you in email, even from people you know. (They could be viruses!)

Check your statements

Check your statements for fraudulent charges periodically, or set up account alerts.

Pay with a credit card

You'll usually get the best liability protection online and offline when you use a credit card.

Check out website security

That small padlock icon in the corner of your URL field tells you that the webpage you're on has privacy protection installed.
